- *Pub Ale*, English-Style Brown Ale
- *Winter Brew*, European-Style Dark/Munchner Dunkel

Bronze Medal Winners

- *Micro-Light*, English-Style Summer Ale [n.b. The only award-winner for this style]
- *Black Bavarian*, German-Style Schwarzbier
- *Oktoberfest*, German-Style Marzen/Oktoberfest

The Los Angeles International Beer Competition is organized and run by the L.A. County Fair. It is registered with the Beer Judge Certification Program (BJCP) and the Brewers Association.
